Wildflower Descriptions



WET: Shorelines/Rain Garden/ Ditches/Watered Garden		
Blue Vervain	Verbena hastata	3-5'; Candelabra-like blue spikes; attracts bees & butterflies
Boneset	Eupatorium perfoliatum	3-5'; Flat top wh flwr heads; butterflies; deer resist; cut flwrs
Cardinal flower	Lobelia cardinalis	2-5'; Fire-red flower spikes; short-lived; butterflies & hummers
Fireweed	Epilobium angustifolium	3-4'; Showy pink; flwrs bottom up; purp pods; colonizes; hummers
Helen's Flower	Helenium autumnale	4-5'; Prolific late season bloom & nectar; bees; deer resistant
Joe Pye Weed	Eutrochium maculatum	3-6'; showy mauve flwrs; wet or dry; butterfly magnet; deer resist
Swamp Milkweed	Asclepias incarnata	2-4'; Pink vanilla-scented flwrs; butterflies attracted++; reseeds
Tall Meadow Rue	Thalictrum dasycarpum	4-6'; Airy white flowers on stout upright plant; masses/background
MEDIUM MOIST SOILS: Average garden/Field/Pollinator plantings		
Brown-eyed Susan	Rudbeckia triloba	2-5'; Bushy; adaptable/disturbed soils; many pollinators; reseeds
Culver's Root	Veronicastrum virginicum	5'; Lg vertical plant w/ white spires; cut back after flwr; butterflies
Harebells	Campanula rotundifolia	1'; Dainty blue bell flwrs; 2-3 months; also dry soil; bees visit
New England Aster	Aster nova-angliae	2-4'; adaptable; important late season nectar; deer resist; reseeds
Pale Purple Coneflower	Echinacea pallida	2-3'; Drooping lav-pink petals; attracts butterflies & birds; reseeds
Prairie Phlox	Phlox pilosa	8-15"; Bright pink; cut flower; butterflies, moths, bees; deer like
Rough Blazing Star	Liatris aspera	2-3'; Upright spikes of bright pink flwrs; dry tolerant; butterflies+
Thimbleweed	Anemone cylindrica	15"-30"; Drought tolerant; thimble-like flower head; deer resist
Wild Columbine	Aquilegia canadensis	2'; unique flwr; adaptable; reseeds; hummingbirds and bees
DRY SOILS: Drought tolerant/Roadside/Gravel/Sand/Tough places/Pollinator plantings		
Pearly Everlasting	Anaphalis margaritacea	8-12"; Woolly white coating on lvs; flwrs dry well; very tough
Whorled Milkweed	Asclepius verticillata	8-20"; Late wh flwrs; thin lvs; great pollinator plant; deer resist
Butterflyweed	Asclepius tuberosa	1-2'; vivid flwrs; tap root; deer resist; butterflies & hummers
Wild Strawberry	Fragaria virginiana	6"; Groundcover; sm red fruit; used by birds, mammals, insects
Wild Bergamot/Beebalm	Monarda fistulosa	3-4'; Very adaptable; aromatic lvs; bees/butterflies/hummers
Yellow Prairie Coneflwr	Ratibida pinnata	5-6'; Drooping yellow petals; sways in breeze; reseeds; butterflies
Ohio Spiderwort	Tradescantia ohiensis	2'; Early season blue flwrs; linear lvs; close in heat; bees; reseeds
WOODLAND: Shady/Rich moist soil		
Bellwort/Merrybells	Uvularia grandiflora	12-18"; spring; dainty drooping yellow petals; forms clumps
Wild Leek	Allium tricoccum	4-12"; Ephemeral; edible bulb and foliage in spring
Wild Ginger	Asarum canadense	2-8"; Heart shped lvs; native groundcover; early flwrs under lvs
Wild Geranium	Geranium maculatum	1-2'; Long bloom- showy pastel flwrs; lvs red in fall; many insects
Wintergreen	Gaultheria procumbens	2"-6"; wintergreen flav lvs and red fruit; acidic soil; wildlife food
Great White Trillium	Trillium grandiflorum	1'; lg 3-petal wh flwr ages to pink; bulb root; protect from deer
GRASS *SEDGE* FERNS: Stabilization/Wildlife/ Accents		
Little Blue Stem	Andropogon scoparius	2-3'; warm season, clump grass; bl-gr lvs turn pink; wh seed tufts
Bottlebrush Sedge	Carex comosa	2-3'; Shoreline-wet areas; bottle brush seed head; wildlife food
Sweet Grass	Heirochloe odorata	1-2'; Dried grass has vanilla fragrance; used for smudging; moist
Maidenhair Fern	Adiantum pedatum	15-30"; Graceful, fan-like fronds; rich, moist forest; a diva
